The entries will be exhibited during an Annual Conference held at the Institute for Education on the 4<sup>th</sup> July 2022 named: "Feel and Achieve". The following are the rules for the Art Competition.

#### Rules and Regulations

1. Drawings need to have the **name, surname, school class and a contact mobile number at the back of the drawing.**
2. Drawings have to be participants' **original** work. Plagiarised work will be disqualified.
3. Drawings can be done in colour or monochrome.
4. Drawings should be on A3 or A4 paper. No other sizes will be accepted.
5. Good technique is important but creativity will also be judged.
6. The closing date is **Monday 16<sup>th</sup> May, 2022.**



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7. Entries should be sent to **Dr Amanda Bezzina, Institute for Education, Martin Luther King Road, Pembroke, PBK1990** from **Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> May 2022 to Monday 16<sup>th</sup> May 2022**.
8. The drawings will be assessed and the first three winning entries will receive books as a gift, sponsored by the National Literacy Agency. The winners will also receive a certificate, which will be presented on the day when the conference will be held.
9. Artwork may be collected from IFE after the conference.
