The Institute for Education is accepting applications submitted online for the non-accredited course **Using Online Collaborative Technologies with Young Learners** commencing in **April 2019** at the **Institute for Education, Martin Luther King Hall, Martin Luther King Road, Pembroke**.

The aim of this course is for Early Years educators to become aware of, and familiarise themselves with a number of free online tools that they can use in order to create resources for and with their students.

The course will have a duration of 6 weeks with two face-to-face sessions. Participants will be expected to carry out 25 hours of work on the course. Due to the blended nature of delivery, there will be a high degree of flexibility with regard to completing the weekly tasks.
