The Institute for Education is accepting applications submitted online **as from 09:00hrs of 20 June 2022** for the part-time blended course Bachelor of Education (Hons) (MQF 6, 180 ECTS) starting in September 2022. While applications will be on a first-come first-served basis, persons engaged as supply educators in the subject applied will be given first preference. **Work experience is only verified against: GP47 or Jobsplus Employment History. CVs and letters of reference are not considered as proof of experience.**

Course Details

This degree programme provides course participants with a strong foundation in pedagogy, assessment, inclusive practices and educational theory. It aims to provide those within or wishing to join the education sector with the necessary tools and competences to teach effectively in the classroom whilst fostering a supportive and inclusive learning environment. It also serves as a pathway to further studies.

Subject specialisations currently on offer include:

- Engineering Technology
- Fashion and Textiles
- Hairdressing and Beauty



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- Health and Social Care
- Hospitality
- Physical Education
- Business Education and Retail

The successful completion of the qualification may not be the only requirement for employment and therefore applicants are responsible to contact the appropriate departments to be informed of additional requirements for the desired employment.

Get Qualified Scheme

This course falls under the Get Qualified Scheme, an initiative supporting the achievement of qualifications and certifications required by industry. Upon successful completion of the qualification the student may be entitled to benefit from a tax credit to recover part of the costs incurred throughout their studies.

This Scheme is administered by the Ministry for Education and is independent from the Institute for Education.

Minimum entry requirements

Applicants interested in following the degree programme are required to satisfy the eligibility criteria as indicated in the Annex at the end of this circular. Higher full qualifications in the relevant subject areas may also be considered by the Admissions Board.

Applicants are required to submit certificates as well as transcripts to corroborate claims of qualifications currently in their possession.

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Maturity Clause

This clause permits an applicant who satisfies the following conditions to apply for consideration to participate in a course as a mature student. Apart from any additional eligibility requirements, the applicant must:

- i. be in possession of the School Leaving Certificate / Secondary School Certificate and Profile;
- ii. be in possession of an MQF Level 3 in Mathematics, Maltese and English Language (Grades 1-5, or equivalent);
- iii. be 23 years old by the date of application.

Applicants who apply under the maturity clause have to demonstrate academic potential and that they have gained academically relevant background knowledge and experience. Applicants are required to sit for an interview where they will need to present a portfolio details of which will be communicated to the interviewees. Following the interview, the Admissions Board may require candidates to undertake additional studies within a stipulated timeframe as a condition for their acceptance. The Board may even recommend an alternative programme where it considers appropriate.

Language Requirement for International Applicants

In addition to the above requirements, international applicants are required to demonstrate English language proficiency with an Academic IELTS score of 6.0, or an equivalent score from another recognised international proficiency examination.

Technological Requirements

All accepted course participants must ensure that they have a strong internet connection and a working microphone and camera for synchronous (live) online sessions.

Student Agreement

As from academic year 2022-2023, accepted applicants which will be enrolled on a qualification programme will be required to endorse a Student Agreement. The purpose of this agreement is to define the conditions of acceptance to undertake studies at the IfE. By signing the agreement both the IfE and the course participant will be agreeing to the stipulated conditions defining the relationship for the duration of studies.

Fees

Upon receiving the acceptance letter by the Institute, applicants from countries in the European Union (EU), Switzerland and countries in the European Economic Area (EEA) are required to pay €950 on an annual basis.

International applicants who are not from the EU, Switzerland or from a country within the EEA are required to pay in full the total cost of the course; €15,200. For further details kindly refer to the Institute's [Tuition Fees Policy](#). Modes and methods of payment will be communicated to the accepted applicants.

Eligible applicants will be selected on a first-come first served basis. However, supply educators teaching the area or subject they are applying



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under will be given first preference*

Disclaimer

The running of all programmes are subject to a minimum number of participants and subject to availability of resources.

Applicants awaiting results for qualifications requested under the minimum entry requirements (with the exception of MQF Level 3 qualifications) may be accepted as Probationary Course Participants. These applicants will be required to provide proof that they are currently awaiting first-sitting results and consequently provide proof of successful attainment of these results.

Annex – Entry Requirements

Participants applying for the *Bachelor of Education (Hons)* are required to be in possession of the following:

Engineering
Technology

1. An MQF Level 3 (Grade 1-5, or equivalent) in Maltese, English Language and Mathematics*;
AND
2. A minimum of one of the following:
 - a) An awarded MATSEC Certificate or equivalent (MQF Level 4) including a grade C or better in two of the following subjects: Mathematics, Physics, Engineering Drawing or Graphical Communication;
OR
 - b) An MQF Level 4 vocational qualification with a minimum of 120 ECTS in Engineering Technology or a cognate area deemed relevant by the Institute for Education;
OR
 - c) Three subjects at Advanced Level (MQF Level 4) including a grade C or better in two of the following subjects: Mathematics, Physics, Engineering Drawing or Graphical Communication; and at least a grade D in a third subject;
OR
 - d) Two subjects at Advanced Level (MQF Level 4) at grade C or better in two of the following subjects: Mathematics, Physics, Engineering Drawing or Graphical Communication and three intermediate subjects with a minimum grade D.



Fashion and Textiles	<p>1. An MQF Level 3 (Grade 1-5, or equivalent) in Maltese, English Language and Mathematics*; AND</p> <p>2. A minimum of one of the following:</p> <p>a) An awarded MATSEC Certificate or equivalent (MQF Level 4) preferably including a grade C or better in Art at Intermediate level; OR</p> <p>b) An MQF Level 4 vocational qualification with a minimum of 120 ECTS in Fashion and Textiles or a cognate area deemed relevant by the Institute for Education; OR</p> <p>c) Three subjects at Advanced Level (MQF Level 4) including a grade C or better in two of the subjects, preferably including Art, and at least a grade D in a third subject; OR</p> <p>d) Two subjects at Advanced Level (MQF Level 4) at grade C or better in two subjects preferably including Art and three intermediate subjects with a minimum grade D.</p> <p>3. In addition to the above, all applicants may be required to sit for an interview and present a portfolio illustrating their work and training in relation to the subject area prior to acceptance to the programme.</p>
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Hairdressing and Beauty	<p>1. An MQF Level 3 (Grade 1-5) in Maltese, English Language and Mathematics*; AND</p> <p>2. A minimum of one of the following:</p> <p>a) An awarded MATSEC Certificate or equivalent (MQF Level 4) preferably with a grade C or better in Biology or Chemistry or Home Economics at Intermediate Level; OR</p> <p>b) An MQF Level 4 vocational qualification with a minimum of 120 ECTS in Beauty Therapy or Hairdressing or a cognate area deemed relevant by the Institute for Education; OR</p> <p>c) Three subjects at Advanced Level (MQF Level 4) with a grade C or better in two of the subjects, preferably including Biology or Chemistry or Home Economics, and at least a grade D in a third subject; OR</p> <p>d) Two subjects at Advanced Level (MQF Level 4) at grade C or better and three intermediate subjects with a minimum grade D. Preference will be given to those with Biology, or Chemistry or Home Economics at grade C or better at intermediate level.</p> <p>3. In addition to the above, all applicants may be required to sit for an interview and present a portfolio illustrating their work and training in relation to the subject area prior to acceptance to the programme.</p>
Health and Social Care	<p>1. An MQF Level 3 (Grade 1-5, or equivalent) in Maltese, English Language and Mathematics*; AND</p> <p>2. A minimum of one of the following:</p> <p>a) An awarded MATSEC Certificate or equivalent (MQF Level 4) including a grade C or better in Biology or Chemistry or Physics or Home Economics or Sociology or Psychology at Intermediate Level; OR</p> <p>b) An MQF Level 4 vocational qualification with a minimum 120 ECTS in Health and Social Care, Nutrition, Childcare or a cognate area deemed relevant by the Institute for Education; OR</p> <p>c) Three subjects at Advanced Level (MQF Level 4) including a grade C or better in Biology or Chemistry or Physics or Home Economics or Sociology and another subject, and at least a Grade D in the third subject; OR</p> <p>d) Two subjects at Advanced Level (MQF Level 4) at grade C or better including</p>



	Biology or Home Economics and three intermediate subjects with a minimum grade D.
Hospitality	<p>1. An MQF Level 3 (Grade 1-5, or equivalent) in Maltese, English Language and Mathematics*; AND</p> <p>2. A minimum of one of the following:</p> <p>a) An awarded MATSEC Certificate or equivalent (MQF Level 4) including a Grade C or better in Home Economics at Advanced Level; OR</p> <p>b) An MQF Level 4 vocational qualification with a minimum of 120 ECTS in Hospitality or a cognate area deemed relevant by the Institute for Education; OR</p> <p>c) Three subjects at Advanced Level (MQF Level 4) including a grade C or better in Home Economics and another subject, and at least a grade D in a third subject; OR</p> <p>d) Two subjects at Advanced Level (MQF Level 4) at grade C or better including Home Economics and three intermediate subjects with a minimum grade D.</p>
Physical Education	<p>1. An MQF Level 3 (Grade 1-5 or equivalent) in Maltese, English Language and Mathematics*; AND</p> <p>2. A minimum of one of the following:</p> <p>a) An awarded MATSEC Certificate or equivalent (MQF Level 4) with a Grade C or better in Physical Education at Intermediate Level; OR</p> <p>b) An MQF Level 4 qualification with a minimum of 120 ECTS in Sports, Coaching or a cognate area deemed relevant by the Institute for Education; OR</p> <p>c) An awarded MATSEC Certificate (MQF Level 4) together with a signed reference from the respective sport's association or MOC providing evidence of a minimum of three (3) years active participation in a particular sport; OR</p> <p>d) Two subjects at Advanced Level (MQF Level 4) at grade C or better, with an intermediate in Physical Education at grade C and two intermediates with a minimum grade D.</p> <p>3. In addition to the above, applicants may be required to sit for a coordinative and fitness test.</p>



Business Education and Retail	<p>1. An MQF Level 3 (Grade 1-5, or equivalent) in Maltese, English Language and Mathematics*; AND</p> <p>2. A minimum of one of the following:</p> <p>a) An awarded MATSEC Certificate or equivalent (MQF Level 4) including a Grade C or better in Economics, Marketing or Accounts at Advanced Level; OR</p> <p>b) An MQF Level 4 qualification with a minimum of 120 ECTS in Business Studies, Marketing, Commerce, Accounts, Finance, or Economics or a cognate area deemed relevant by the Institute for Education; OR</p> <p>c) Three subjects at Advanced Level (MQF Level 4) including a grade C or better in Economics, Marketing or Accounts and another subject, and at least a grade D in a third subject; OR</p> <p>d) Two subjects at Advanced Level (MQF Level 4) at grade C or better including Economics, Marketing or Accounts and three intermediate subjects with a minimum grade D.</p>
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**Applicants not in possession of the MQF Level 3 requirements may be exempt subject to being in possession of an MQF Level 5 (120 ECTS) Higher Diploma taught in English language or an MQF Level 6 (180 ECTS) taught in English language.*
