The Institute for Education is accepting late applications submitted online as from **09:00hrs of 20 June 2022** for the part-time blended course Master of Education (MQF 7, 90 ECTS) commencing in **September 2022**. While applications will be on a first-come first-served basis, persons engaged as supply teachers in the chosen area of specialisation shall be given first preference. **Work experience is only verified against: GP47 or Jobsplus Employment History. CVs and letters of reference are not considered as proof of experience.**

Course Details

This programme is targeted towards individuals who wish to enhance their skills and competences in pedagogy. The target audience is either graduates wishing to join to education sector, or persons already within education sector with an interest to follow an initial teacher training programme. It aims to equip participants with the necessary tools and competences to teach effectively in the 21st century classroom whilst fostering a supportive and inclusive environment for learning.

Exit Qualification

Applicants following this programme will have the possibility to exit with a:

- Postgraduate Certificate in Education (upon completion of 30 ECTS)
- Postgraduate Diploma in Education (upon completion of 60 ECTS)

Minimum Entry requirements

Applicants interested in following this programme are required to satisfy the eligibility criteria as indicated in the Annex at the end of this circular.

Language Requirement for International Applicants

In addition to the above requirements, international applicants are required to demonstrate English language proficiency with an Academic IELTS score of 6.5, or an equivalent score from another recognised international proficiency examination.

Technological Requirements

All accepted course participants must ensure that they have a strong internet connection and a working microphone and camera for synchronous (live) online sessions.

Student Agreement

As from academic year 2022-2023, accepted applicants which will be enrolled on a qualification programme will be required to endorse a Student Agreement. The purpose of this agreement is to define the conditions of acceptance to undertake studies at the IfE. By signing the agreement both the IfE and the course participant will be agreeing to the stipulated conditions defining the relationship for the duration of studies.

Fees

Upon receiving the acceptance letter by the Institute, applicants from countries in the European Union (EU), Switzerland and countries in the European Economic Area (EEA) are required to pay €750 on an annual basis.

International applicants who are not from the EU, Switzerland or from a country within the EEA are required to pay in full the total cost of the course; €9,000. For further details kindly refer to the Institute's [Tuition Fees Policy](#). Modes and methods of payment will be communicated to the accepted applicants.

Get Qualified Scheme

This course falls under the Get Qualified Scheme, an initiative supporting the achievement of qualifications and certifications required by industry. Upon successful completion of the qualification the student may be entitled to benefit from a tax credit to recover part of the costs incurred throughout their studies.

Master of Education Mathematics	<p>Minimum Entry Requirements</p> <p>Applicants are required to be in possession of the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A Bachelor Degree (MQF Level 6 with a minimum of 180 ECTS) with a minimum of 60 ECTS in Mathematics.
Master of Education Ethics	<p>Minimum Entry Requirements</p> <p>Applicants are required to be in possession of the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A Bachelor Degree (MQF Level 6 with a minimum of 180 ECTS) with a minimum of 60 ECTS in Philosophy or a cognate area deemed relevant by the Institute for Education.
Master of Education Sciences	<p>Minimum Entry Requirements</p> <p>Applicants are required to be in possession of the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A Bachelor Degree (MQF Level 6 with a minimum of 180 ECTS) with a minimum of 60 ECTS in the natural sciences: Biology, Chemistry and/or Physics.
Master of Education Agribusiness	<p>Minimum Entry Requirements</p> <p>Applicants are required to be in possession of the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A Bachelor Degree (MQF Level 6 with a minimum of 180 ECTS) with a minimum of 60 ECTS in Agribusiness or a cognate area deemed relevant by the Institute for Education.* <p>*Applicants in possession of a degree deemed relevant, though lacking specific modules in Agribusiness subject content, may be accepted to the programme on the condition that additional modules are followed as part of their studies.</p>
Master of Education Engineering Technology	<p>Minimum Entry Requirements</p> <p>Applicants are required to be in possession of the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A Bachelor Degree (MQF Level 6 with a minimum of 180 ECTS) with a minimum of 60 ECTS in Engineering Technology or a cognate area deemed relevant by the Institute for Education.* <p>*Applicants in possession of a degree deemed relevant, though lacking specific modules in Engineering Technology subject content, may be accepted to the programme on the condition that additional modules are followed as part of their studies.</p>



Master of Education Business Education and Retail	<p>Minimum Entry Requirements</p> <p>Applicants are required to be in possession of the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. A Bachelor degree (MQF Level 6 with a minimum 180 ECTS) with a minimum of 60 ECTS in Business Studies, Accounts, Retail or a cognate area deemed relevant by the Institute for Education or equivalent. <p>OR</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">2. ACCA Certificate recognised at MQF Level 6 or higher.
Master of Education Health and Social Care	<p>Minimum Entry Requirements</p> <p>Applicants are required to be in possession of the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. A Bachelor degree (MQF Level 6 with a minimum 180 ECTS) with a minimum of 60 ECTS in Health and Social Care or Home Economics or Physical Education or Psychology or Sociology or Health Care profession or a cognate area deemed relevant by the Institute for Education.* <p>*Applicants in possession of a degree deemed relevant though lacking specific modules in Health and Social Care subject content may be accepted to the programme on the condition that additional modules are followed as part of their studies.</p>
Master of Education Drama	<p>Minimum Entry Requirements</p> <p>Applicants are required to be in possession of the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. A Bachelor degree (MQF Level 6 with a minimum 180 ECTS) with a minimum of 60 ECTS in Theatre Studies.
