The Institute for Education is accepting applications submitted online as from **3pm of 13th May 2019** for the part-time online course *Master in Applied Educational Leadership* starting in **October 2019.** Applications will be on a first-come first-served basis and limited to the first twenty-five (25) eligible applicants.

Course Details:

This programme is targeted towards leaders in educational settings who wish to upgrade their qualifications or are interested in developing their professional knowledge. It is also intended for those professionals who wish to pursue a career as a leader/manager/administrator in an Educational setting.

Applicants following this programme will have the possibility to exit with a:

- Postgraduate Certificate in Applied Educational Leadership (upon completion of 30 ECTS)
- Postgraduate Diploma in Applied Educational Leadership (upon completion of 60 ECTS)

Minimum entry requirements

Applicants are required to be in possession of a minimum of **ONE** of the following:

a) A Bachelor degree in Education (MQF Level 6 with a minimum of 180 ECTS, or equivalent) and evidence of three (3) years teaching experience (or equivalent professional status in an educational institution/organisation);

OR

b) A Bachelor Degree (MQF Level 6 with a minimum of 180 ECTS, or equivalent) and PGCE (or equivalent) and evidence of three (3) years teaching experience (or equivalent professional status in an educational institution/organization);

OR

c) A full MQF Level 5 qualification (with a minimum of 120 ECTS, or equivalent) in addition to evidence of eight (8) years professional work experience. Applicants applying under this criteria will also be invited for an interview to assess their eligibility for the programme.

Language Requirement for International Applicants

In addition to the above requirements, international applicants are required to demonstrate English language proficiency with an Academic IELTS score of 6.5, or an equivalent score from another recognised international proficiency examination.

Fees

Upon receiving the acceptance letter by the Institute, applicants from countries in the European Union (EU), Switzerland and countries in the European Economic Area (EEA) are required to pay €500 per academic year.

International applicants who are not from the EU, Switzerland or from a country within the EEA are required to pay in full the total cost of the course; €3,750 (80% of which is non-refundable except under exceptional circumstances).
