The Institute for Education is accepting late applications submitted online **as from Friday, 12th June 2020** for the part-time blended course *Master of Education (MQF 7, 90 ECTS)* commencing **October 2020**. Applications are limited and will be served on a first-come first-served basis.

Course Details

This programme is targeted towards individuals who wish to enhance their skills and competences in pedagogy. The target audience is either graduates wishing to join to education sector, or persons already within education sector with an interest to follow an initial teacher-training programme. It aims to equip participants with the necessary tools and competences to teach effectively in the 21st century classroom whilst fostering a supportive and inclusive environment for learning.

Subject specialisations currently on offer are:

- English
- Sciences
- Agribusiness
- Engineering Technology
- Hospitality
- Mathematics

Remaining places on the programme are limited and will be served on a first-come first-served basis.

Exit Qualification

Applicants following this programme may exit the qualification after two years and will be entitled to a Postgraduate Diploma in Education (MQF 7) upon successfully completing 60 ECTS of the programme.

Minimum Entry requirements

Applicants interested in following this programme are required to satisfy the eligibility criteria as indicated in the Annex at the end of this circular.

Language Requirement for International Applicants

In addition to the above requirements, international applicants are required to demonstrate English language proficiency with an Academic IELTS score of 6.5, or an equivalent score from another recognised international proficiency examination.

Fees

Upon receiving the acceptance letter by the Institute, applicants from countries in the European Union (EU), Switzerland, UK and countries in the European Economic Area (EEA) are required to pay €360 on an annual basis.

International applicants who are not from the EU, Switzerland, UK or from a country within the EEA are required to pay in full the total cost of the course: €2,700. Modes and methods of payment will be communicated to the accepted applicants.

Get Qualified Scheme

Annex – Entry Requirements

Participants applying for the *Master of Education (MQF 7)* are required to be in possession of the following:

English

AND

1. An MQF Level 3 (Grade 1-5, or equivalent) in Maltese, English Language and Mathematics;
2. A Bachelor degree (MQF 6 with a minimum 180 ECTS) with a minimum of 60 ECTS in English Language and Literature.

Sciences

AND

1. An MQF Level 3 (Grade 1-5, or equivalent) in Maltese, English Language and Mathematics;
2. A Bachelor degree (MQF 6 with a minimum 180 ECTS) with a minimum of 60 ECTS in the natural sciences: Biology, Chemistry and/or Physics.

Agribusiness

1. An MQF Level 3 (Grade 1-5, or equivalent) in Maltese, English Language and Mathematics

AND

2. A Bachelor degree (MQF 6 with a minimum 180 ECTS) with a minimum of 60 ECTS in Agribusiness or a cognate area deemed relevant by the Institute for Education.*

In addition to the above, applicants may be requested to sit for an interview and present a portfolio illustrating their work and training in relation to the subject area prior to acceptance on the programme.

*Applicants in possession of a degree deemed relevant though lacking specific modules in Agribusiness subject content may be accepted on the programme on the condition that additional modules are followed as part of their studies.

1. An MQF Level 3 (Grade 1-5, or equivalent) in Maltese, English Language and Mathematics

AND

Engineering Technology

2. A Bachelor degree (MQF 6 with a minimum 180 ECTS) with a minimum of 60 ECTS in Engineering Technology or a cognate area deemed relevant by the Institute for Education.*

In addition to the above, applicants may be requested to sit for an interview and present a portfolio illustrating their work and training in relation to the subject area prior to acceptance on the programme.

*Applicants in possession of a degree deemed relevant though lacking specific modules in Engineering Technology subject content may be accepted on the programme on the condition that additional modules are followed as part of their studies.

1. An MQF Level 3 (Grade 1-5, or equivalent) in Maltese, English Language and Mathematics

AND

Hospitality

2. A Bachelor degree (MQF 6 with a minimum 180 ECTS) with a minimum of 60 ECTS in Hospitality or a cognate area deemed relevant by the Institute for Education.*

In addition to the above, applicants may be requested to sit for an interview and present a portfolio illustrating their work and training in relation to the subject area prior to acceptance on the programme.

*Applicants in possession of a degree deemed relevant though lacking specific modules in hospitality subject content may be accepted on the programme on the condition that additional modules are followed as part of their studies.

1. An MQF Level 3 (Grade 1-5, or equivalent) in Maltese, English Language and Mathematics;

Mathematics

AND

2. A Bachelor degree (MQF 6 with a minimum 180 ECTS) with a minimum of 60 ECTS in Mathematics or a cognate area deemed relevant by the Institute for Education.
