The Institute for Education is accepting applications submitted online for the part-time course *Postgraduate Certificate in Education (Primary)* (MQF 7, 30 ECTS) in **October 2018**. Whilst applications are on a first come first-serve basis, preference will be given to participants currently employed as supply teachers in the primary sector.

Course Details:

This programme offers the opportunity for a number of educators who are qualified to teach in the secondary sector and are currently deployed in primary schools. The aim of this programme is to develop the required knowledge, skills, attitudes and competences in educators to teach in the primary sector.

Graduates from this programme will also have the opportunity of progressing to second year of a Master of Education (Primary) (MQF 7, 90 ECTS).

Minimum entry requirements

Participants applying for the course are required to be in possession of a **Bachelor of Education (MQF 6)** in a secondary subject.

Language Requirement for International Applicants

In addition to the above requirements, international applicants are required to demonstrate English language proficiency with an Academic IELTS score of 6.5, or an equivalent score from another recognised international proficiency exam.

Fees

Upon receiving the acceptance letter by the Institute, applicants from countries in the European Union (EU), Switzerland and countries in the European Economic Area (EEA) are required to pay €360. International applicants who are not from the EU, Switzerland or from a country within the EEA are required to pay in full the total cost of the course; €900. The fees to be paid will be confirmed in the Acceptance Letter, of which 80% is non-refundable except under exceptional circumstances. Places are limited to twenty (20) eligible applicants who will be selected on a first-come first served basis. However, educators currently employed in the primary sector will be given first preference. Late applications will not be considered.
