The Institute for Education is accepting applications submitted online for the part-time course *Master of Education (MQF 7, 90 ECTS)* in **October 2018**. While applications will be on a first-come first-served basis, persons engaged as supply teachers shall be given first preference.

Course Details:

This programme is targeted towards professionals who wish to enhance their skills and competences in pedagogy. The target audience is either qualified individuals wishing to join to education sector, or persons already within education sector with a need to upgrade their qualifications. It aims to equip participants with the necessary tools and competences to teach effectively in the 21st century classroom whilst fostering a supportive and inclusive environment for learning.

Subject specialisations currently on offer include:

- Primary Education (maximum 20 applicants)
- Physical Education (maximum 12 applicants)
- Humanities (maximum 12 applicants)
- Agribusiness (maximum 7 applicants)
- Hospitality (maximum 7 applicants)

Exit Qualification

Applicants following this programme shall be entitled to a Postgraduate Diploma in Education (MQF 7, 60 ECTS) upon completing two years of this programme in pedagogy.

Minimum Entry requirements

Participants applying for the course are required to be in possession of a relevant Bachelor's degree at MQF Level 6 with a minimum of 180 ECTS, or equivalent.

Language Requirement for International Applicants

In addition to the above requirements, international applicants are required to demonstrate English language proficiency with an Academic IELTS score of 6.5, or an equivalent score from another recognised international proficiency exam.

Fees

Upon receiving the acceptance letter by the Institute, applicants from countries in the European Union (EU), Switzerland and countries in the European Economic Area (EEA) are required to pay €360 for the first year of the course. International applicants who are not from the EU, Switzerland or from a country within the EEA are required to pay in full the total cost of the course; €2,700. The fees to be paid will be confirmed in the Acceptance Letter, of which 80% is non-refundable except under exceptional circumstances.
