

BAGB101 VET Logistics for Agribusiness

Module Description

This module is designed to provide the students with the skills needed to plan the logistics for the teaching of Agribusiness. The students will also be given the necessary training to be able to design the necessary assignments in accordance with the curriculum criteria. The unit will also give the students the opportunity to acquire a thorough understanding of Agribusiness and the vocabulary needed to be able to design assignments in line with the curriculum's objectives and criteria. By the end of the module the students will be able to formulate a quality assurance plan that will enable the teachers of Agribusiness to provide a safe environment for teaching and learning both in a classroom setting and also outside in the field. In this module the students are expected to produce schemes of work based on particular units. They will also be expected to be able to verify their colleagues' assignments. The students will be encouraged to apply the knowledge acquired to prepare assignments and also to write health and safety reports and make risk assessments based on different situations one may encounter when teaching this subject.

- d. Write a report with the hazards encountered in a specific animal farm.
