The Institute for Education is accepting applications submitted online **as from 4.30 pm of 17 May 2023** for the part-time blended course *Postgraduate Certificate in Digital Competences for Education (MQF 7, 30 ECTS)* commencing in **September 2023.**

Course Details

This programme provides participants with formal training to those working within the education profession who wish to upgrade their digital skills and competences in the area of digital literacies. The Digital Competence Framework for Educators (DigCompEdu) was the framework which was taken into consideration in the development of this programme. Applications will be on a first-come first-served basis and limited to the first eight (25) eligible applicants.

Minimum Entry Requirements

Participants applying for the Postgraduate Certificate in Digital Competences for Education are to be in possession of **ONE** of the following:

1. A first degree at MQF Level 6 (minimum of 180 ECTS, or equivalent) in the area of education or inclusive education;

OR

2. A first degree at MQF Level 6 (minimum of 180 ECTS, or equivalent) in addition to a Postgraduate Certificate in Education (MQF 6, 60 ECTS) or equivalent.

Applicants are required to submit certificates as well as transcripts to corroborate claims of qualifications currently in their possession.



Language Requirement for International Applicants

In addition to the above requirements, international applicants are required to demonstrate English language proficiency with an Academic IELTS score of 6.5, or an equivalent score from another recognised international proficiency examination.

Technological Requirements

All accepted course participants must ensure that they have a strong internet connection and a working microphone and camera for synchronous (live) online sessions.

Student Agreement

Accepted applicants who will be enrolled on a qualification programme will be required to endorse a Student Agreement. The purpose of this agreement is to define the conditions of acceptance to undertake studies at the IfE. By signing the agreement both the IfE and the course participant will be agreeing to the stipulated conditions defining the relationship for the duration of studies.

Fees

Upon receiving the acceptance letter by the IfE, applicants from countries in the European Union (EU), Switzerland and countries in the European Economic Area (EEA) are required to pay €390 on an annual basis.

International applicants who are not from the EU, Switzerland or from a country within the EEA are required to pay in full the total cost of the course: €3,200 (80% of which is non-refundable except under exceptional circumstances). For further details kindly refer to the IfE's <u>Tuition Fees Policy</u>. Modes and methods of payment will be communicated to the accepted applicants.

Get Qualified Scheme

This course falls under the Get Qualified Scheme, an initiative supporting the achievement of qualifications and certifications required by the industry. Upon successful completion of the qualification, the student may be entitled to benefit from a tax credit to recover part of the costs incurred throughout their studies.

The running of all programmes is subject to a minimum number of participants and subject to availability of resources.

Applicants awaiting results for qualifications requested under the minimum entry requirements (with the exception of MQF Level 3 qualifications) may be accepted as Probationary Course Participants. These applicants will be required to provide proof that they are currently awaiting first-sitting results and consequently provide proof of successful attainment of these results.
